

## **Announcement from The Northern Nevada Breastfeeding Coalition**

The Northern Nevada Breastfeeding Coalition consists of current/former breastfeeding moms, WIC staff, hospital nurses and lactation consultants, other professionals in maternal and child health, and other community members. Our mission is to promote breastfeeding awareness in Nevada.

The Northern Nevada Breastfeeding Coalition will be funding two applicants to attend the CAPPa Certified Lactation Educator (CLE) Training.

This funding will cover the cost of registering for the course. Applicants will be responsible for their own travel costs and housing, if required. In addition, the scholarship does not cover the additional cost of completing the CLE credential or CAPPa membership. Awardees will receive discounted admission to Northern Nevada Breastfeeding Coalition education events.

With a goal of increasing diversity among providers in the lactation field and increasing access to lactation support in Northern Nevada, priority will be given to candidates committed to working with traditionally under-served communities, such as communities of color or rural communities with limited access to resources. Applications are due by March 23, 2018 and should be emailed to [meredith.pollaro@gmail.com](mailto:meredith.pollaro@gmail.com).

Applicants will be notified if they have been selected by March 30, 2018.

“Certified Lactation Educators (CLEs™) provide evidence-based information to the community, families and professionals to encourage an increase in breastfeeding initiation, duration and support. CLEs are found teaching community and hospital based breastfeeding classes, as peer breastfeeding counselors in hospital and public health setting, facilitation support groups, running pump rental stations and providing phone support.”
